## Study and intern in Dublin through Auburn University!

Ireland's capital is a cosmopolitan city with much to offer and a delightful and friendly community. The program is based at Griffith College, where students will enjoy fully equipped classrooms and campus lodging and cafeteria. This is an ongoing program that has openings each semester. Students studying in Dublin can take advantage of an extensive network of internship sites, offering mostly placements for the following academic tracks:

- The Creative Arts
- Exploring the Media
- Human Rights, Crime and Journalism
- Globalization and International Trends in Business and Society

This program includes:

- Optional part-time internship placement
- Choice of contextual courses for up to 12 credits for the semesters and 6 for the summer
- Arrival Program Orientation and Reception
- City bus tour of Dublin and a full day excursion to Belfast, Northern Ireland
- Spring semester housing in shared apartments (flats), conveniently located on the Griffith College campus
- Summer session housing in either single homestays with breakfast and dinner provided daily or shared furnished apartments within the city of Dublin
- Students can cook meals in their flats or eat at the Griffith College cafeteria
- Weekly program of subsidized cultural and social activities
- **Pre-Departure** and on-site support, orientations, and assistance
- Mid-term dinner (semesters only) and Farewell Ceremony
- Medical and travel **insurance** coverage for the length of the program
